# Class Procedures

When the bell rings at the beginning of class, I need to take out \_\_\_\_\_ Number things.

The first thing is my \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective worksheet. I will have one worksheet each \_\_\_\_\_ Noun. I will hand this in on \_\_\_\_\_ Day of the Week.

The second thing is my \_\_\_\_\_ Noun. I will put this on top of my \_\_\_\_\_ Noun.

At the beginning of class, I may only get up in order to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form.

During lectures and discussions, if I have a question, I need to raise my \_\_\_\_\_ Noun. I should wait \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb until I am called on.

Opening my mouth and making any sounds is considered \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING and may not be done unless I am called on.

I should take \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural about the lecture slides. I will have a one minute warning before the slide is taken down.

If

I need to use the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun during a lecture or discussion, I can go ahead as long as I take the bathroom  
\_\_\_\_\_ Noun. There is one pass for \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural and one pass for \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural.

If I need to borrow something from a friend, I can go ahead as long as I \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form. If it is during a  
\_\_\_\_\_ Noun, I can not borrow anything.

If I need to throw something away during a lecture or discussion, I need to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form until a better  
time. If it is \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective or \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective work time, I can go ahead. If it is urgent, I need to  
\_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form my hand.

During group or individual work, a volume level of 2 means we can talk \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb. 1 means we can  
\_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form. 0 means we have to be \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective.

When Ms. Dugger needs our attention, she will count down from \_\_\_\_\_ Number. I need to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base  
\_\_\_\_\_ Form, put down my pen, and \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form at her before she gets to 1.

The first two times I \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form a rule during a class period, I will get a \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective warning.
