What is a Mission Statement?

A mission statement is a Noun which is used as a Noun of communicating the Noun of the Noun. A Noun is different from a Noun in that the Adjective is the cause and the Noun is the effect; a Noun is something to be accomplished whereas a Noun is Noun to be pursued for that Noun.
