At the end of the number rounds, each Noun adds their wins and losses and Noun - Plural and Noun - Plural and get to verb out a Noun if they have the most, if they don't get a Noun then they get a boobie Noun as a consolation Noun. we have been playing Noun (most are from the original group) for around number
