The Reception & Concierge Desks is the Adjective point of contact between the Noun and our Club. It is therefore the first opportunity the Club gets to Verb and create a lasting impression. It is our Noun to create an exceptional and memorable experience for every Noun and Noun who Verb - Non 3rd Person Singular Present through our Noun - Plural. The Reception or Concierge is likely the first Noun that a Proper Noun will Verb with at the club which makes our role very important. As such, the service delivery by Member Services is a Noun of who we are as a Club.

Reception vs. Concierge: The Reception Desk is typically responsible for Adjective and guests, taking payments, answering or transferring Verb - Present Tense enquiries, controlling access, etc. while the Concierge is typically responsible for making Noun - Plural for activities in and around the city, and to provide or find information about local features such as Verb - Present Tense, sports or recreational activities, destination breaks, and obtaining tickets for events. They are also responsible for issuing locker keys and locker rentals, making travel arrangements for sightseeing, receiving, storing and delivering dry-cleaning and Noun - "everything from the Adjective to the Noun".
