Reaper Bird's is made up of the body of Astigmatism, with Astigmatism's "legs" serving as
Reaper Bird's areas at the top and bottom of its eye (which
would typically be the sclera of a real eye) are repurposed as gnashing teeth which occasionally close over the
pupil.
Reaper Bird's are made from Final Froggit's legs while its own legs are unnaturally-extended
versions of Whimsalot's Noun - Plural.

except slightly fatter. His head has a short appendage resembling a snout, and small black circles for eyes.
