# The Vegetable Monster

But I shouldn't have Verb - Past Tense away. The low Noise gets Adjective and Adjective, the vegetable monster gets Adjective and bigger until it's life size! I Verb - Base Form in shock and I Verb - Base Form backwards. I fall off my Noun in the process. But I don't care. The vegetable monster's about to eat me!

Then I hear my Noun being called out. "First Name of a Person! Don't forget to eat ALL your vegetables!" my Same Female Relative shouts. (She HAS come to Verb - Base Form me!)

I Verb - Base Form back at the monster. It has Verb - Past Tense to every word my Same Female Relative said, and is Verb - Present ends in ING away. But all it's done is Verb - Base Form itself! I Verb - Base Form towards it while my Same Female Relative turns around, takes a selfie with me and the monster in the Noun. I even heard the camera Noise. There is a Adjective silence, but it is soon broken by a Adjective fart. My Same Female Relative and I Adverb Verb - Base Form around and we Verb - Base Form at one another, while the vegetable monster Verb - Present ends in S there Verb - Present ends in ING. We Verb - Base Form without Verb - Present ends in ING, and then we look at the monster. It now has Food coloured Part of Body Plural. Then we hear ANOTHER Adjective fart. This time it's a little Noise! The monster Verb - Present ends in S around, looking Feeling. It faces the Noun.

NOW we can all smell Type of Vegetable farts!

that doesn't reduce my Noun. I love my veggies! And as I Verb - Base Form towards it with my  
Piece of Cutlery and Piece of Cutlery in Part of Body, it suddenly Verb - Present ends in S  
before my Part of Body Plural. It's now back to its Adjective size on my Same Dish, in the  
shape of a Feeling Part of Body!
