# MOMS Club Code of Conduct - Part 2

## Noun - Plural Behavior Policy

The MOMS Club(r) activities are meant to be Adjective and Adjective events for both Noun - Plural and Noun - Plural. The MOMS Club(r) respects parenting differences, but expects that all children Adjective Adverb at MOMS Club(r) activities. Adjective behaviors will not be Verb - Past Tense. These Adjective behaviors include, but are not limited to:

Verb - Present ends in ING,

Verb - Present ends in ING property,

Hair Verb - Present ends in ING,

Verb - Present ends in ING,

Verb - Present ends in ING,

Verb - Present ends in ING, and

Adverb Adjective behavior.

In the Adjective event that these Noun - Plural occur during MOMS Club(r) activities, then the child's mother should remove her child from the area.

When Verb - Present ends in ING your child, please remove the child from the Adjective area and do so in a Adjective tone of Noun so as not to further Adjective or Adjective others in the group. In situations that involve Adjective behavior(s), the mother should Verb - Base Form the child from the area for an Adjective period of time. The child's Noun will be expected to keep an especially Adjective watch over the child if attempt to Verb - Base Form Verb - Base Form on another child is made. If the child attempts the Noun a second time at the same activity, the mother must Verb - Base Form the child from the MOMS Club(r) activity for that day.

## Mother's Noun Policy
