On July 2, 1776, the Proper Noun Congress formally voted for Noun , and issued its Declaration on July 4. However, it was not until August 2, 1776 that the Declaration of Noun was taken into place and first signed by Proper Noun . Meanwhile, the Proper Noun were mustering Noun - Plural to suppress the Noun . Sir William Howe outmaneuvered and defeated Washington, capturing New York City and New Jersey. Washington was able to Verb a Proper Noun detachment at Trenton and drive the British out of most of New Jersey. In 1777 Howe's army launched a Noun against the national capital at Philadelphia, failing to aid Proper Noun separate invasion force from Canada. Burgoyne's army was Verb - Past Participle , and surrendered after the Battles of Saratoga in October 1777.
