# Talk like a pirate

Ye can always pretend to be a bloodthirsty Noun, threatening everyone by waving yer Adjective sword in the air, but until ye learn to Verb like a pirate, ye'll never be Adverb accepted as an authentic Noun. So here's what ye do: Cleverly work into yer daily conversations Adjective pirate phrases such as "Ahoy there, Noun - Plural." "Avast, ye Noun - Plural," and "Shiver me Plural body part." Remember to drop all yer g's when ye say such words as sailin', spittin', and Verb ends in IN. This will give ye a Part of Body start to being recognized as a swashbucklin' Noun.
