"A" stands for awareness! As a coach, it is our responsibility to be "present" during a coaching session. We want
to be aware when a new hire makes a mistake, or when they do something great!

"F" stands for future! We want to encourage our new hires to think about their future with the Contact Center
and Wawa to see where they want to be! We want to positive behaviors and give
corrective when necessary.
"E" stands for empower! How does it feel when you get a compliment on a project or task you worked hard on?
I'm sure it felt! Empower new hires to use the skills that they have to their advantage to
improve their overall performance!
