# Toe-Stubbing, the Seminar

We've all done it.

We've all faced the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective times of stubbing our toe on the base of our \_\_\_\_\_ Noun .

Here I'm talking about toe-stubbing, how to avoid it and how to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form with your  
\_\_\_\_\_ Adjective furniture afterwards!

Step \_\_\_\_\_ Number . Make sure you're not in the \_\_\_\_\_ Description of Surroundings eg dark fog etc .

You'll find it's easier to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form when there's \_\_\_\_\_ Description of Surroundings eg dark fog etc in the room,  
because without it, you'd be quite \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective . So next time you go anywhere near an \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective  
toe-stubbing piece of furniture, make sure there is \_\_\_\_\_ Same Description of Surroundings so you can  
\_\_\_\_\_ Verb You Can Do to Someone or Something it.

Step \_\_\_\_\_ Number . Make a beeline away from the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun .

No matter its \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective - Ends in NESS , furniture will still work out a way to stub your toe. What you need to  
do is stay as \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective as possible far from the furniture at all times, and make a \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective  
beeline to the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun you want to get in. Make sure to remain as \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective as possible to avoid  
any toe-stubbing \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural .

Step

\_\_\_\_\_ Number \_\_\_\_\_. The furniture is unforgiving, don't try to say \_\_\_\_\_ Something that Someone Says eg sorry thank you etc \_\_\_\_\_.

The furniture is secretly EVIL!! Over time, you'll find that whatever chance it gets, your furniture will try to stub

your poor \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ defenseless, \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ toe. I mean, you can TRY to say \_\_\_\_\_ Same Thing \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_ that People Say \_\_\_\_\_, but the furniture will just \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form \_\_\_\_\_.

Step \_\_\_\_\_ Number \_\_\_\_\_ - the final step (and most \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_) - Never try to be \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ to your furniture!

As I said, your furniture is \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_, so try to avoid the following:

Saying \_\_\_\_\_ Random Sentence \_\_\_\_\_ !'

Walking off (or \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING \_\_\_\_\_) and just \_\_\_\_\_ Verb You Can Do to Someone or Something - Present Tense \_\_\_\_\_ your furniture

\_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING \_\_\_\_\_ then apologising for it

And many more. Things that you SHOULD do, or what most \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural \_\_\_\_\_ do, is this:

\_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form \_\_\_\_\_, and don't say sorry! Feel PROUD of your \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ Part of Body \_\_\_\_\_!

Push over the furniture with \_\_\_\_\_ Self-Feeling eg confidence pride etc \_\_\_\_\_!

Feel \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_. Go on, stub the furniture's toe on your \_\_\_\_\_ Part of Body \_\_\_\_\_!

Form a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ and team up on the furniture!

If you \_\_\_\_\_ Verb You Can Do to Someone or Something \_\_\_\_\_ most of these, the FURNITURE will gang up on YOU. So come on, together we can help stop the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective - Ends in NESS \_\_\_\_\_ to toes from furniture!
