Toe-Stubbing, the Seminar

We've all done it.

We've all faced the Adjective times of stubbing our toe on the base of our Noun.

Here I'm talking about toe-stubbing, how to avoid it and how to Verb - Base Form with your Adjective furniture afterwards!

So you're walking along in your Room in House, just getting up to Verb - Base Form, when Exclamation! You've stubbed your toe. It's really Adjective when this happens, because there's not much you can do to fix the Adjective - Ends in NESS, but here's a little advice on how to Verb You Can.
Do to Someone or Something that Adjective stub every time you cross your Noun.

Step Number. Make sure you're not in the Description of Surroundings eg dark fog etc.

You'll find it's easier to Verb - Base Form when there's Description of Surroundings eg dark fog etc in the room, because without it, you'd be quite Adjective. So next time you go anywhere near an Adjective toe-stubbing piece of furniture, make sure there is Same Description of Surroundings so you can Verb You Can Do to Someone or Something it.

Step Number. Make a beeline away from the Noun.

No matter its Adjective - Ends in NESS, furniture will still work out a way to stub your toe. What you need to do is stay as Adjective as possible far from the furniture at all times, and make a Adjective beeline to the Noun you want to get in. Make sure to remain as Adjective as possible to avoid any toe-stubbing Noun - Plural.
