A different Preamble

We hold these Noun - Plural to be Adjective, that all men are created Adjective, that they are endowed by their Noun with certain unalienable Noun - Plural, that among these are Noun, Liberty and the pursuit of Proper Noun.

That to secure these Noun - Plural, Governments are instituted among Verb - Present Tense, deriving their just Determiner from the consent of the Determiner, That whenever any Form of Adjective becomes Determiner of these ends, it is the Right of the Verb to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Verb - Present Tense, laying its Adjective on such principles and Noun - Plural its powers in such form, as to them Adverb - Superlative seem most likely to effect their Proper Noun and Happiness. Proper Noun, indeed, will dictate that Noun - Plural long Verb - Past Participle should not be Verb - Past Participle for light and transient Noun - Plural; and accordingly all Noun hath shewn, that Noun are more Adjective to Verb, while Noun - Plural are sufferable, than to right Pronoun by abolishing the Noun - Plural to which they are Verb - Past Participle. But when a long Noun of abuses and usurpations, Verb - Present Tense invariably the same Noun evinces a Noun to reduce them Preposition or subordinating conjunction absolute Despotism, it is their Noun, it is their Noun, to Verb off such Noun, and to Verb new Noun - Plural for their Adjective security.
