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Annually, in Utah, we make significant \_\_\_\_\_ Noun and \_\_\_\_\_ Noun investments across all sections of the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun continuum. Despite these investments, \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural based on where our children live, what language they speak first, how much money their parents make, and the color of their skin persist and - in many locations - grow.

In the Kearns High School feeder pattern (total K-12 enrollment: 6,282), disparities are especially apparent. Established in 2011, the Promise Kearns partnership, led by United Way of Salt Lake (UWSL), has been working to address these disparities. UWSL, the lead applicant for the Partnerships for Student Success grant, and Promise Kearns partners recognize that the moment could not be more urgent to invest in the partnerships and systems that will create better results for our children, families, and communities. Promise Kearns draws on the talents and resources of Granite School District, multiple nonprofits, private businesses, government agencies, philanthropies, healthcare organizations, and Salt Lake County. This proposal builds on a framework that exists in four community schools, with a plan to scale that framework to the entire Kearns High Feeder Pattern.
