# Mario Kart Wii

Mario Kart Wii is an Adjective game to play with friends and Noun Plural. You can choose from 24 different characters, and tons of different karts and Noun to race with. There are 8 cups with 4 races each. When Verb Present ends in ING in versus mode, you pick 4 tracks that you race on! For newer players, Yoshi Falls is a good choice, because it's a Adjective loop with no real Noun Plural. A Adjective track would be something like Person in Room Circuit, or DK Summit. And for the most Adjective players, choose something from the Special Cup like Bowser's Noun, or the legendary Rainbow Noun.

Once you start racing, pick up item Noun to gain powerups. Sometimes you'll get a Color Mushroom, or an Invincibility Noun, that will make things easier for you. You could also get a Pow Block or Blooper, that can blind or knock out all the other Noun Plural. Finally, you can get Adjective and banana Noun to make other players spin out, or if you're lucky, the Adjective Shell, which will blow up the player that is in Ordinal Number place.

As you can see, Mario Kart is the Adjective game if you're looking for a fun race game with a slice of Adjective on the side. Happy racing!
