Important Email from the CFO

All -

A number of new Noun Plural have Verb Past Tense up in our Salesforce account.

This is not OK, because each Noun costs \$1600/yr. First Name of a Person and First Name of a
Person are Verb Present ends in ING this today, but going forward, be aware of our policy on
Adverb software like Salesforce.

There are two types of Salesforce Noun Plural:

1) Adjective / Adjective users (UNIQUE SEATS). These include Noun Plural,
Noun, etc. who write data and that data must be Verb Past Tense with them in the audit log, so
they need unique Noun Plural.

2) Adjective users (SHARED SEATS). These are users that Verb Base Form or Verb Base
Form Salesforce data, possibly even create Noun Plural as well, but they don't Verb Base Form
data. These must be Verb Past Tense to the maximum possible, i.e. through Verb Present ends in ING
accounts. Food should be turned off so these Noun Plural are Adverb shareable.
