# Iron Man

Genius, billionaire, playboy and \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Tony Stark, who has inherited the defense contractor  
\_\_\_\_\_ First Name of a Person Industries from his father, is in war-torn \_\_\_\_\_ Location with his friend and military  
\_\_\_\_\_ Noun Lieutenant Colonel \_\_\_\_\_ First Name of a Person Rhodes to demonstrate the new " \_\_\_\_\_ Noun "

workshop. Yinsen \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Present ends in S himself to divert them while the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun is completed. The  
armored Stark battles his way out of the cave to find the dying Yinsen, then \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Present ends in S the Ten  
Rings' \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural in anger and \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Present ends in S away, crashing in the desert and destroying the  
suit by accident. After being rescued by Rhodes, Stark returns home and announces that his company will no  
longer

\_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural. Obadiah Stane, his father's \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective partner and the company's manager, advises Stark that this may ruin Stark Industries and his father's \_\_\_\_\_ Noun. He reveals his secret identity to Rhodes over the phone in an attempt to end the attack. Stane has a \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective new suit reverse engineered from the wreckage. Seeking to track his company's illegal shipments, Stark sends Pepper to hack into its \_\_\_\_\_ Noun.
