Keanu Charles Reeves, whose first name means " Adjective Animal - Plural over the Noun
" in Hawaiian, was born September 2, 1964 in Beirut, Lebanon.

After a few stage gigs and a handful of made-for-TV movies, he scored a supporting role in the hockey flick
Proper Noun, which was filmed in Location. Shortly after the production wrapped, Reeves
Verb Past Tense his Noun and headed for Hollywood.

His first popular success was the role of totally rad dude First Name of a Person Logan in Repeat Last
First Name of a Person & Bill's Excellent Adventure. Over the next few years, Reeves tried to shake the
Repeat Last First Name of a Person stigma with a series of Adjective projects. He played a
Adjective Animal in My Own Private Idaho.

He is a musician and played bass guitar for the bands Dogstar and Proper Noun.

In early 2005, Reeves' accomplishments in Hollywood were recognized by the Hollywood Walk of Fame with a
Noun placed on Hollywood Boulevard.

Reeves has continued acting while exploring other forms of artistry. In October 2014, he played a
