Momma's Original Recipe

To make Momma's Adjective Ends in EST Food follow the steps outlined below:

- 1) Verb Base Form a Adjective Noun **with** fresh, Adjective Liquid.
- 2) Place the Repeat Last Noun on the NOUN at a High low or medium etc NOUN.
- 3) Bring the Repeat Last Noun of Liquid to a boil and Emotion with -ly Verb Base Form in some Spice.
