# 10 ways to memorize song lyrics fast

Here are 10 effective ways to get the job done:

1 - \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form the song lyrics.

What is the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun about and what does every \_\_\_\_\_ Noun and \_\_\_\_\_ Noun mean? Go in to details.

If needed, look it up on the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun ..

2 - Let the feeling of \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb and \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb become part of you.

## 6 - Karaoke

7 - \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form the words in short phrases one \_\_\_\_\_ Noun at a time.

Memorize the first \_\_\_\_\_ Noun and \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form it out loud, \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form the second

\_\_\_\_\_ Noun and \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form out loud. Now \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form the first and second

\_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural together, then \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form the third \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form out loud,

then \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form all \_\_\_\_\_ Number \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural together and so on.

8 - Go \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb
