Mum's Meat Loaf

Ah...home Verb ends in ING. Here's how to make Noun loaf exactly like Mum's:

1. In a Noun, combine Large number Noun Plural, a pound of chopped Body part,
Adjective salt, Noun paste, and mustard.

2. Crumble meat over the mixture and mix Adverb. Sprinkle with onion and Noun crumbs. Mix
again

and shape into two Noun Plural.

3. Place the Noun Plural in the centre of a lightly floured Noun.

4. Bake at Number degrees for Number minutes.

5. For the sauce, take some melted Noun Plural and whisk in Liquid until it's completely
Adjective. Stir in one Noun

and two Noun Plural. If you like, you can substitute a Noun for the flour.

Finally, when your Noun Plural refuse to eat your Adjective creation, storm out of the room and
shout, "Nobody appreciates me!"
