Grant Approved

The city approved a Noun application that could land Ridgecrest an \$8 million community Noun.

The Ridgecrest City Council and staff have been Verb Present ends in ING since last year to secure up to \$8.5 million of the Statewide Noun Development and Community Noun Grant Program. After holding multiple public Noun Plural to gather community Noun, the city selected a public Noun as the best project to Verb Base Form for the competitive funds.

The original Noun deadline of December has been Verb Past Tense to March 14, so the city has ample time to Verb Base Form a completed Noun.

The proposed Noun includes a 25 yard x 25 meter competition Noun, a children's Noun, snack Noun, Noun and Noun facilities and a multipurpose Noun to rent out for parties and Noun Plural.
