Final Fantasy VII is the Number main Noun in the Final Fantasy series, Verb Ending in ED
and published by Proper Noun. It was released in Month Year for the PlayStation, and
was later Verb Ending in ED for the Microsoft Windows, PlayStation Number, PlayStation Portable,
PlayStation Vita, PlayStation Number, iOS, Android, Xbox Number and Switch platforms, it is
also included on the PlayStation Classic Adjective console. It was directed by Full Name of a Person,
produced by Full Name of a Person, with a score produced by Full Name of a Person and Adjective
designs by Tetsuya Nomura. It was the first title in the series to feature Number dimensional graphics,
Adjective backgrounds and Adjective full motion videos, and the first to be Verb Ending in
ED in Europe.

Final Fantasy VII follows the story of Profession Cloud Strife, who is Verb Ending in ED by the
eco-terrorist group Group Name by Full Name of a Person --to help Verb Base Form the
Adjective corporation Corporation Name Electric Power Company, who attempts to drain the
planet's Noun as an energy source to further their profits. Feeling to the cause, Cloud initially
Verb Present ends in S for personal gain, and for the promise he made to childhood friend Full Name of
a Person. Cloud eventually Verb Present ends in S forces with many others to Verb Base Form the
planet, which is Verb Ending in ED by Corporation Name and Cloud's Adjective nemesis
Sephiroth, and Verb Present ends in S a reason to Verb Base Form for a cause other than his own.
