The Nets know they can be a Adverb Adjective team when Simmons Verb Present ends in S at a high level and is Adjective on the Location.

"He just got downhill -- he just Verb Past Tense Adverb," Durant said of Simmons. "He didn't Verb Base Form too much. I think we're all Adverb Adjective to start Verb Present ends in ING, start the season last game, so we had a better start to the Noun. He Verb Past Tense the Noun as much as he could tonight.
