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48. Straight from the animal possessive body part

Meaning: Directly from the Noun involved.

Example: Listen to the news straight from the person possessive body part, his Noun
burned down right in front of his eyes.

49. Crying animal

Meaning: To ask for Noun when you don't need it.

Example: You have cried Noun so many times that no one verb plural modifying a noun you now.

50. verb present tense modifying a noun off

Meaning: Pass off something as genuine when it is spurious.

Example: This shopkeeper always verb plural modifying a noun off old stock to the Noun Plural.

51. Has adjective ending in er animal to fry

Meaning: Has more important work to do.

Example: Please don't bother me today with any Noun Plural, I have bigger Noun to fry.

52. Look before you Verb Base Form

Meaning:

Calculate the risks before advancing towards a Noun.

Example: You can't just sell all of your shares when the market is Adjective, look before you leap,

Trump is coming tomorrow, it is Noun Plural the shares will Verb Base Form.

53. On Adjective ice

Meaning: In a precarious or risky situation.

Example: Person played hooky from work for a week saying he was sick, now his boss said that he is on

very Adjective Noun.

54. Play devil's Noun

Meaning: To Verb Base Form, just for the sake of it.

Example: He was not agreeing to back off, as if he was playing person possessive advocate.
