# How to Make a Paper Airplane

looking for a quick diversion from the grind of adulthood or are teaching a youngster DIY skills, these

beginner or intermediate level. The materials are Adjective and only require paper, a pair of

Noun Plural, a ruler, and some double Verb Base Form Noun (optional) to complete. For

Adjective results use a flat, thin-edged ruler. Make Adjective creases along each edge. Adding

double stick tape to the inside of the body keeps the Noun Plural from separating in flight.

## Model 1) The Dart

1. Verb Base Form the paper in half vertically.

2. Unfold the paper and fold each of the top corners into the center Noun.

3. Fold the top edges into the center line.

4. Fold the Noun Plural in half toward you.

5. Fold the wings down, matching the top Noun Plural up with the bottom edge of the body.

6. Add double stick tape to the inside of the body. The Adjective plane should look like its name, a

Noun.

## Model 2) The Stealth

1.

Fold the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ in half vertically.

2. Unfold the paper and fold each of the top corners into the center line.

3. \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form \_\_\_\_\_ the peak toward you and 3/4" from the bottom of the paper.

4. Fold both top \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural \_\_\_\_\_ into the center line.

5. Fold the remaining tip over the two \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural \_\_\_\_\_ at the center line to lock them in place.

6. Fold the plane in half away from you.

7. \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form \_\_\_\_\_ the wings down 1" from the bottom of the plane.

8. Fold up the sides of each wing 1/2" tall.

9. Cut two small slits at the back of each \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_. Fold up the tabs.

10. Add double stick \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ to the inside of the body. The finished plane is built for gliding

\_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ distances.
