# How to Plan a Scavenger Hunt

If your family is growing \_\_\_\_\_ *Adjective* \_\_\_\_\_ of normal go-to activities, you can \_\_\_\_\_ *Verb Base Form* \_\_\_\_\_ things up a bit by \_\_\_\_\_ *Verb Present ends in ING* \_\_\_\_\_ your very own scavenger hunt! Scavenger hunts can be as long or \_\_\_\_\_ *Adjective* \_\_\_\_\_ as you like and can be done indoors, outdoors or a combination of both. They can involve finding \_\_\_\_\_ *Noun Plural* \_\_\_\_\_ or just following clues to the next spot. You can create a hunt that is kid-friendly or opt for a more \_\_\_\_\_ *Adjective* \_\_\_\_\_ set of clues for adults. It really is whatever you decide.

Here's how to get started:

1) Choose your location(s) and time of day. \_\_\_\_\_ *Verb Base Form* \_\_\_\_\_ where you would be okay with the participants going and plan accordingly. You may not want your little ones going near fragile \_\_\_\_\_ *Noun Plural* \_\_\_\_\_, but going to the toy bin is fair game. Likewise, if the scavenger hunt is for \_\_\_\_\_ *Noun Plural* \_\_\_\_\_, you may want to have more \_\_\_\_\_ *Adjective* \_\_\_\_\_ locations. Time of day and weather are important if you're opting to have an \_\_\_\_\_ *Adjective* \_\_\_\_\_ hunt.

2) Decide what type of scavenger hunt you want to \_\_\_\_\_ *Verb Base Form* \_\_\_\_\_. You can make a list of items you want participants to \_\_\_\_\_ *Verb Base Form* \_\_\_\_\_ and have the search be a free-for-all or you can set up clues to \_\_\_\_\_ *Verb Base Form* \_\_\_\_\_ them in a certain order.

Create your lists. If you want to have \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural brought to you, generate a list of the objects to give to scavenger hunt \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural. If you want them to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form clues, create the list of hints and the coordinating locations.

4) Hide the clues and/or \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural. Make sure they're not in \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective sight.

5) Give each team the list of \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural and/or clues. If you're giving \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural, make sure each person's are in a different order so they don't \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form each other around.

First one to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form all the clues and grab the final object \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Present ends in S!
