We can't. I'm going to be Adjective.

Miss Pauling: [Confused] Wait, what?

Soldier: [Poking his Part of Body into the Repeat Last Location] Good news! We're not  
Verb Present ends in ING! We are going to Verb Base Form forever!

[The Heavy Verb Present ends in S the side of the monster's body, allowing light to flood over Scout and  
Miss Pauling.]

Medic: I didn't say that! I just said we're not filled with Noun Plural!

Scout: Oh thank God. [Verb Present ends in S and Verb Present ends in S] So yeah, Miss Pauling. I guess  
it's a date.

Miss

Pauling: Actually this is my only Unit of Time off this Unit of Time.

Scout: Oh...

Miss Pauling: Oh, but you can Verb Base Form along with me on some jobs. [brings out a Noun ]

[The camera slowly pulls back to reveal the body of the monster, which now lays Adjective. Engineer and Medic are seen at the bottom of the shot Verb Present ends in ING . Spy flicks open his Container , plucks a Noun out of it, then snaps it closed again. Heavy grabs one of the detached Body Part Plural and heaves it off to one side, then Verb Present ends in S over to the Demoman, who is carrying a case of Liquid under his Part of Body. The Sniper is on the Part of Body of the monster, Verb Present ends in ING his Noun. As the camera pulls back farther, the Pyro can be seen Verb Present ends in ING into the shot, who has the small bread monster Verb Present ends in ING around his Body Part Plural like a Animal as they try to keep track of it.]

Miss Pauling: Tomorrow...I'm Verb Present ends in ING the Noun Plural off a pile of Noun Plural.

Scout: Ah, no.

Miss Pauling: Oh! You can help me \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Base Form the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural out of a box full of

Scout: No to that.
