# Exposure risk

\_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural that lower or increase risk of \_\_\_\_\_ Noun

Length of time: How long were you with the infected \_\_\_\_\_ Noun?

Longer \_\_\_\_\_ Noun time increases the risk of \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun (for example, contact longer than \_\_\_\_\_ Number minutes is more likely to result in \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun than two minutes of \_\_\_\_\_ Noun).

Cough or heavy breathing: Was the infected person coughing, singing, \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Present ends in ING, or breathing \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb?

Activities like coughing, singing, \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Verb Present ends in ING, or breathing \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb due to exertion increase the risk of \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun.

Symptoms: Did the infected person have \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural at the time? i

Being around people who are \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective increases the risk of \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun.

Masks: Were you or the infected \_\_\_\_\_ Noun or both \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Present ends in ING a respirator (for example, N95) or \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective mask?

If one person was wearing a mask, the risk of \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun is \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Past Tense, and if both people were wearing masks, the risk is substantially \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Past Tense. Risk is also lower if the mask or respirator is a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun that offers greater \_\_\_\_\_ Noun.

Ventilation and filtration: How well-ventilated was the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun?

More \_\_\_\_\_ Location air can decrease the risk of \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun. Being \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Location would be lower exposure risk than \_\_\_\_\_ Verb Present ends in ING indoors, even with \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective ventilation and filtration; both of those options would be lower risk than \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Verb Present ends in ING indoors with \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective ventilation or filtration.

Distance: How close was the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective person to you?

Being closer to someone who is \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Adjective with COVID-19 increases the risk of \_\_\_\_\_ Repeat Last Noun. Crowded \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural can raise your likelihood of being close to \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Plural with COVID-19.
