## JN.1.2

First Verb Past Tense as part of the BA.2.86 'Pirola' strain, Juno has now been classified as a subvariant by the World Health Noun (WHO), and a variant of Adjective in its own right. Both strains are descendants of Omicron.

In their latest Noun, WHO maintained that JN.1 poses Adverb low risk to Adjective health, especially in well-vaccinated Noun Plural such as the UK. However, the rapid Verb Base Form of the strain may indicate that it is more transmissible than Adjective variants.

While the WHO has Verb Past Tense JN.1 as a "variant of interest," the organization said it poses a Adjective additional public Noun risk.

"Considering the Adjective, yet limited evidence, the additional public health Noun posed by JN.1 is Adverb evaluated as low at the global Noun," the organization Verb Past Tense on 19 December.
