_____ Adjective lawmakers in _____ State on Wednesday will try for a third time to _____ Verb Base Form an 1864 law _____ Verb Present ends in ING abortion, plunging the _____ Adjective State Legislature back into a divisive election-year battle over abortion rights.

The previous attempts to _____ Verb Base Form the _____ Adjective ban ended in chaotic failure after Republican leaders _____ Verb Past Tense efforts by Democrats and a handful of _____ Noun Plural of their own party.

_____ Proper Noun Plural said that this time they were _____ Verb Present ends in ING for new support and looking for other _____ Noun Plural to bring their repeal measure to a vote. But it was unclear whether any _____ Adjective Republican lawmakers were willing to _____ Verb Base Form their own leaders and _____ Adjective anti-abortion groups and force a vote in the House, which is narrowly divided.

"There's too much time for _____ Verb Present ends in ING and too many _____ Verb Present ends in ING parts," said Representative Stephanie Stahl Hamilton, a Democrat who has introduced a _____ Adjective measure to repeal the 1864 law. Her bill has yet to get a _____ Noun.

The Legislature's unwillingness to undo the law, which has galvanized _____ Noun Plural and which many voters call _____ Adjective and _____ Adjective, has created a rift within the Republican Party. The measure would not go into effect before June 8, said Attorney General Kris Mayes, a Democrat.

Prominent _____ Noun Plural, including former President _____ Proper Noun, have urged the Legislature to _____ Verb Base Form the law, hoping to refocus the _____ Adjective conversation on _____ Noun and _____ Noun. But _____ Adjective abortion opponents who hold sway in _____ State have urged Republican state lawmakers not to overturn the ban.
