Cats are similar in anatomy to the other felids, with <u>Adjective</u> flexible bodies, quick reflexes, sharp retractable claws, and teeth adapted to killing small prey. As crepuscular predators, cats use their acute hearing and ability to see in near darkness to locate prey. Not <u>Noun</u> can cats <u>Noun</u> sounds too faint for human ears, they can also hear sounds higher in frequency than humans can perceive. This is because the usual prey of cats (particularly rodents such as mice) make high frequency noises, so the hearing of the <u>Noun</u> has evolved to pinpoint these faint high-pitched sounds. Cats also have a much better sense of smell than humans
