Climate change is a major threat to Noun . Remember that organisms are adapted to their environments and have specific tolerance ranges to temperature and other abiotic conditions. If conditions change beyond an Adjective tolerance, the organism must move to a more suitable location or face extinction.

 Adjective in fragmented habitats are particularly vulnerable to climate change because if conditions change they may not be able to move easily to a suitable habitat. Estimates vary regarding the effects of climate change on biodiversity. If global temperature increase 1.5C-2.5C over late Number temperatures, Number percent of species studied are likely to face increased risk of extinction. If the global temperature increase goes beyond Number it is likely that 40-70 percent of species studied will face extinction.
