Wild species are the originial source of many medicines, including penicillin like asprin and antibiotics like penicillin. The <u>Pural noun</u> in wild species are used to treat diseases like depression and cancer. For example, the foxglove, shown in FIGURE 6-14, contains <u>Noun</u> called digitalins that are <u>Past</u> to <u>Verb</u> heart diease. These plant compounds are assembled according to instructions coded in genes. So the genetic information carried by diverse species is like a "natural <u>Noun</u>; from which we have a great deal to learn.
