# Elements to Know: Literary Terms to Know

a division within a play, much like the chapters of a novel

Act- a division of a play

Aside- lines that are spoken by a character directly to the audience

Comedy- a Adjective work of drama

Dialogue- conversation between Number or more characters

Noun a work of literature designed to be performed in front of an audience

Monologue- a Adjective speech spoken by a character to himself, another character, or to the audience

Noun a division of an act into smaller parts

Location directions- italicized comments that identify parts of the setting or the use of props or costumes, give further information about a character, or provide background information

Noun a serious work of drama in which the hero suffers catastrophe or serious misfortune, usually because of his own actions

Tragic hero- a protagonist with a fatal flaw which eventually Present tense verb to his demise
