# Kama Sutra - On Sexual Union

Man is divided into three classes, viz. the hare man, the bull man, and the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective man, according to the size of his \_\_\_\_\_ Noun.

## THE EMBRACE

The embrace indicates the mutual love of a man and woman who have come together is of four kinds: touching, rubbing, piercing and \_\_\_\_\_ Verb ending in ing.

When a man under some pretext or other goes in front or alongside of a woman and touches her \_\_\_\_\_ Noun with

his own, it is called the touching embrace.

When a woman in a lonely place bends down, as if to pick up \_\_\_\_\_ Plural noun and pierces, as it were, a man sitting or standing, with her breasts, and the man in return takes hold of them, it is called a piercing embrace.

The above two kinds of embrace take place only between persons who do not, as yet, speak \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb with each other.

When two lovers are \_\_\_\_\_ Verb ending in ing slowly together, either in the dark, or in a place of public resort, or in a lonely place, and rub their \_\_\_\_\_ Plural noun against each other, it is called a rubbing embrace.

last embrace is peculiar to those who know the intentions of each other.
