Connery's breakthrough came in the role of secret agent ______. He played the character in seven

Bond

films: Dr. No, From <u>Location</u> with Love, <u>Movie title</u> <u>Movie title</u> You Only Live Twice, <u>Plural noun</u> Are Forever, and Never Say <u>Noun</u> Again. All <u>Number</u> films were

commercially successful.

James Bond's creator, Ian Fleming, doubted the casting, saying, 'He's not what I <u>Past tense verb</u> of James Bond looks' and 'Im looking for <u>Adjective</u> Bond and not an overgrown <u>Noun</u>, adding that Connery was unrefined. However, Fleming's girlfriend told him Connery had the requisite sexual <u>Noun</u>. Fleming changed his mind after the successful Dr. No premiere; he was so <u>Past tense verb</u> he created a half-Scottish, <u>Adjective</u> heritage for the literary James Bond in the later <u>Plural noun</u>.
