# Rats and Human Health Impacts

Rats have significant agricultural, natural resource, and human health impacts in the Location Islands.

Where they are used, current control techniques provide inconsistent levels of protection from Noun damage, and more effective methods for control are needed. Recognizing this need, Proper noun directed the establishment of a research project in cooperation with the Hawaii Agricultural Research Center. This project , by investigating a wider variety of methods to resolve Adjective Noun damage to agriculture, reforestation, structures & equipment, also fulfills one of the USDA-APHIS-Wildlife Services program research needs identified in a research needs assessment. Project staff will Verb with other state and federal Plural noun and private organizations to develop techniques to Verb Plural noun and other vertebrate species in natural areas. Research efforts covered by this project document will address, when appropriate, the pest control needs of the Hawaiian Adjective Noun and the conservation community.
