Extinction of Dinosaurs

The sudden mass extinction of non-avian dinosaurs, an event that occurred approximately 65 million years ago, is one of the most Adjective mysteries in paleontology. Many other groups of animals also became extinct at this time, including Plural noun herbivorous turtles and crocodiles, most Plural noun and many groups of mammals.
