Rules For Riding the School Bus

1. Every morning, your bus runs a Adjective route, so you must be sure that you arrive at your local Noun early.
2. While waiting, do not Verb in the middle of the street. You might get run over by a Adjective Noun.
3. When you see the bus, wave your Noun.
4. Before boarding, make sure you have all your Adjective books and your lunch Noun.
5. When you board the bus, do not push or jostle any of the smaller Plural noun. Go to the nearest empty seat and Verb.
6. Do not talk to the Noun while the bus is in motion.
7. Do not throw Plural noun at the other students.
8. Instead of wasting time by Verb ending in ing use the trip to study your Plural noun.

9. Follow these rules and you will have a Adjective ride and Verb on time at your Adjective school.
