# Car Insurance

In the United States, liability insurance covers claims against the policy holder and generally, any other operator of the insureds \_\_\_\_\_ Noun provided they do not \_\_\_\_\_ Verb at the same \_\_\_\_\_ Noun as the policy holder and are not specifically excluded on the policy. In the case of those \_\_\_\_\_ Verb ending in ing at the same address, they must specifically be covered on the policy. Thus it is necessary for example, when a family \_\_\_\_\_ Noun comes of driving age they must be added on to the policy. Liability insurance sometimes does not \_\_\_\_\_ Verb the policy holder if they operate any \_\_\_\_\_ Plural noun other than their own.
